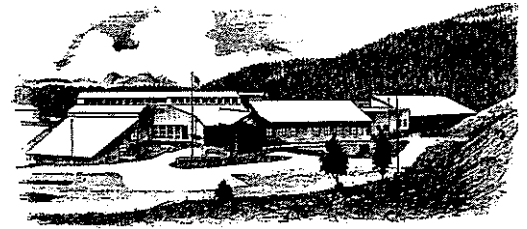

Dear Parent/Student:

Welcome to Clear Creek High School for the 2017-2018 school year! This letter contains information for the opening of school. The first day of school is on Monday, August 21, 2017, starting at 8:20 a.m.

Registration: All returning and new students to the district need to register to attend CCHS. Registration will be held at the high school during the following dates and times:

- Monday, August 14: Grades 8, 10, 11 & 12.....3pm-6pm
- Tuesday, August 15: Grades 8, 10, 11 & 12.....9am-12pm
- 9th Grade & New HS Student Orientation: Tuesday, August 15, 6:00 pm—8:00 pm

All registration documents will be distributed during registration or you can save time by visiting the website and downloading the forms at cchs.ccsdre1.org under the "Parent & Students" tab.

Starting this year, Chromebooks (laptops) will be issued and distributed to all HS students during registration.

Be aware that any student with **incomplete or missing paperwork** will be considered a non-registered CCHS student and **will not** be able to attend classes until paperwork is completed and returned. Students who have **not paid** outstanding fees, **will not** be allowed to complete registration, or receive their schedule for the 2017-2018 school year.

Attendance: Please refer to the student handbook regarding all tardy and attendance rules and procedures. Please note that students who are excessively tardy will face disciplinary action and lose privileges such as participating in extra-curricular activities.

Infinite Campus/Parent Portal: The administration and staff are very pleased with the increased communication with both our students and parents due to Infinite Campus/Parent Portal. Parents who are actively involved in their student's academic progress and overall school performance find that their child works accordingly to reach their maximum potential.

Cafeteria: Breakfast is served daily from 7:50 a.m. until 8:15 a.m. at the cost of \$1.55. Lunch is available in the cafeteria, or students may bring lunch from home. The high school lunch price is \$2.90. Parents can put money in a student's lunch account via the Infinite Campus Parent Portal.

Student schedules: Students will receive a copy of their schedule at registration and/or after all mandatory paperwork is completed and turned in and all fees have been paid. Students should preview their schedule on the Infinite Campus Student Portal. Students and parents with scheduling questions may call the counseling office at 303-679-4608.

Handbook/Planner: All students will receive an updated copy of the Clear Creek High School Student Handbook within their complimentary planner. The handbook/planner **MUST** be with the students at all times as this is also used as a hall pass.

Dress Code: Please refer to the Student Handbook for more information. A safe and disciplined learning environment is essential to a quality educational program. District-wide standards on student attire are intended to help students concentrate on schoolwork, reduce discipline problems, and improve school order and safety. IF AN ITEM IS DEEMED INAPPROPRIATE, THE STUDENT WILL BE REFERRED TO THE OFFICE. Students who violate the dress code will be asked to change, and parents will be contacted for any dress code violations. The principal or principal designee's discretion shall be the final determination of appropriateness of dress.

Parent Teacher Conferences: Attendance at conferences is highly recommended. This is your chance to talk to teachers in person regarding your student's progress grades. These are scheduled to take place this year on September 20-21, 2017, and February 14-15, 2018. Please refer to the 2017-2018 School Calendar.

Parking Permit: ALL students driving to school will be required to have a parking permit to park in the designated student parking lot at CCHS. The cost of the permit is \$35.00. Parking permit forms are available on the website and also in the school office and must be signed by both the parent and student.

School Bus: Regular school bus transportation is available to all students. Please direct any bus route questions to the transportation office by calling 303-567-3865. Routes can also be found on the website.
